

- Our clinical team includes a patient care coordinator, dedicated breast sonographer, and breast radiologist assistant (who facilitates report creation and history taking/presentation).
- KBC has developed many best practices including:
 - History Gathering: our team is specially trained to gather pertinent data for each diagnostic case and follow up with patients to ensure each tracked finding is addressed (each symptom, each open BI-RADS 0, 3, 4, etc).
 - Real time visualization of mammogram or prior ultrasound exams while performing real-time sonography. Thus, our radiologists can compare prior BI-RADS 3 findings on prior ultrasound examinations while simultaneously obtaining current images, ensuring the correct plane orientation and patient position is reproduced.
 - Scribe/Dictation: Reports are made in real-time, and radiologists sign off as completed, which maximizes image reading time and minimizes report reading time.
